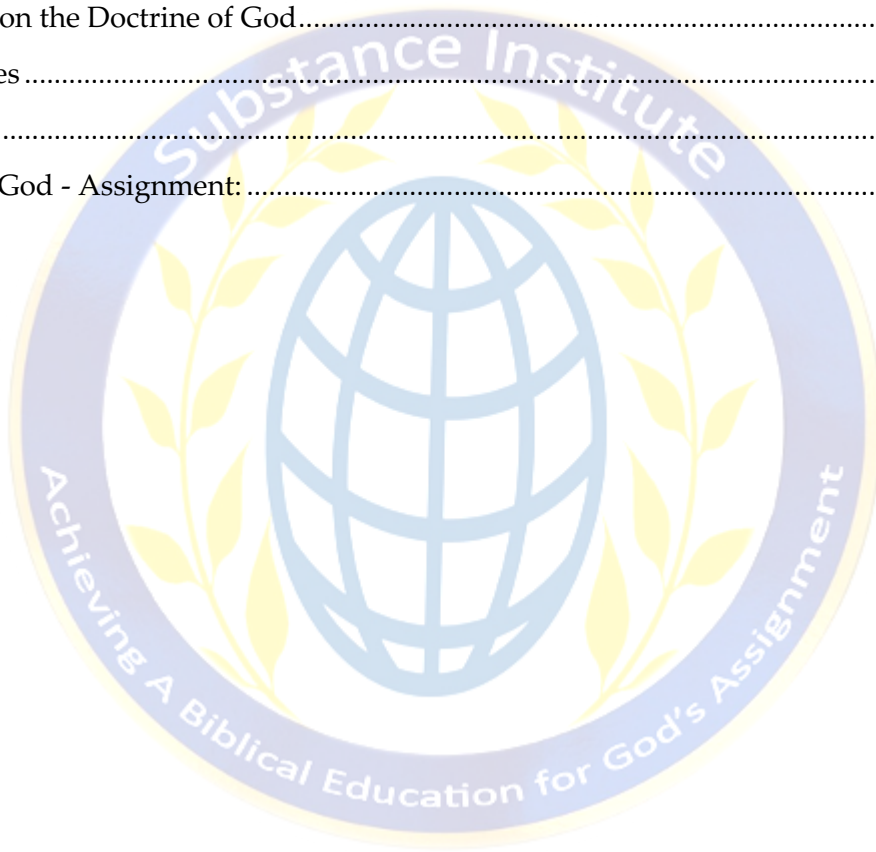


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## The Doctrine of God

Within this section or within the course we will be defining the doctrine of God, looking at God's existence, God's nature, God's attribute based on the word of God and not based on what men has said or what I will say.

### Introduction

The first time the word "God" is mentioned in the Bible is in the book of Genesis and therefore we must go there. We see in the first four words of the Bible within Genesis 1:1 "In the beginning God"<sup>1</sup>. God was the creator of all that is in existence today. Once he created, spoke, called forth, and made; it is still so today.

It is in first chapter of Genesis, we learn that God did or said the following:

## God's Existence

In Psalms 14:1 state "The fool hath said in his heart, There is no God. They are corrupt, they have done abominable works, there is none that doeth good."<sup>5</sup>

Dr. Orr, of Glasgow, says: "What we mean by the proof of God's existence is simply that there are necessary acts of thought by which we rise from the finite to the infinite, from the caused to the uncaused, from the contingent to the necessary, from the reason involved in the structure of the universe to a universal and eternal reason, which is the ground of all, from morality in conscience to a moral Lawgiver and Judge."<sup>6</sup>

Religion was not produced by proofs of God's existence and will not be destroyed by its insufficiency to some minds. Religion existed before argument; in fact, it is the preciousness of religion that leads to the seeking for all possible confirmations of the reality of God.<sup>7</sup>

Think about a watch, it tells us time. We wear it because it is something that we need when we need it. But how did that watch get here? How does a watch exist? A watch exist because it has a watch maker, a creator, a designer and therefore, a watch as a function and purpose.

God's existence is not based on the whether we belief, it is not based on what we think, neither is it based on how we feel. God's existence is based on what He has done. What He has spoken. God is a person and not a thought. He is not a thing but has essence, personality, description, features, attributes, traits as we will discuss in the nature of God.

God is a spirit - John 4:24 states "God is a Spirit: and they that worship him must worship him in spirit and in truth".

### God's Nature

Before we can talk about the nature of God, we must define the word "Nature". The dictionary. In the thesaurus states that the nature is the essence, personality, description, features, attributes, traits, just to name a few.

I want to say this before we get in this section on God's nature. We will all believe that there is a God, or we will believe that our nature does not exist. We are not self-sufficient. We are not self-independence from our creator who is our designer. We are created in His image and is likeness and God gave man dominion based on Genesis 1:26 - 28 says <sup>26</sup> "And God said, Let us make man in our image, after our likeness: and let them have dominion over the fish of the sea, and over the fowl of the air, and over the cattle, and over all the earth, and over every creeping thing that creepeth upon the earth. <sup>27</sup> So God created man in his own image, in the image of God created he him; male and female created he them. <sup>28</sup> And God blessed them, and God said unto them, Be fruitful, and multiply, and replenish the earth, and subdue it: and have dominion over the fish of the sea, and over the fowl of the air, and over every living thing that moveth upon the earth."<sup>9</sup>

Let's discuss God's nature which is based on these things His Personality and Attributes:

#### 1) His Personality

Exodus 3:14 - "I AM THAT I AM." - This name is wonderfully significant. Its central idea is that of existence and personality. The words signify "I AM, I WAS, I SHALL BE," so suggestively corresponding with the New Testament statement concerning God: "Who wast, and art, and art to come."

All the names given to God in the Scripture denote personality. (See the many more names and scriptures in the name of God). Here are some of them:

Jehovah Jireh: The Lord will provide (Genesis 22:13, 14)

Jehovah-Rapha: The Lord that healeth (Exodus 15:26)

Jehovah-Nissi: The Lord our Banner (Exodus 17:8-15)

God's Love – 1 John 4:8-16, 1 John 3:16; John 3:16, Matt 3:17, Matt 17:5, Luke 20:13

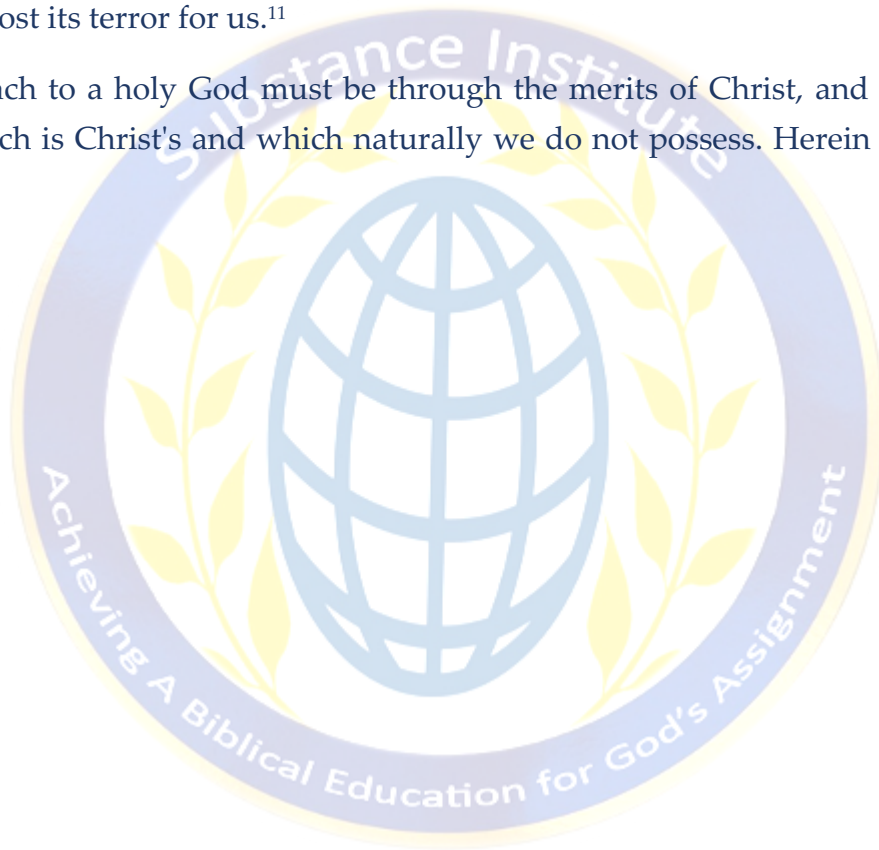


## Conclusion on the Doctrine of God

First, we should approach God with "reverence and godly fear" (Heb. 12:28). In the story of Moses' approach to the burning bush, the smiting of the men at Bethshemesh, the boundary set about Mt. Sinai, we are taught to feel our own unworthiness. There is too much hilarity in our approach unto God. Eccl. 5:1-3 inculcates great care in our address to God.<sup>10</sup>

Second, we shall have right views of sin when we get right views of God's holiness. Isaiah, the holiest man in all Israel, was cast down at the sight of his own sin after he had seen the vision of God's holiness. The same thing is true of Job (40:3-4; 42:4-5). We confess sin in such easy and familiar terms that it has almost lost its terror for us.<sup>11</sup>

Third, that approach to a holy God must be through the merits of Christ, and on the ground of a righteousness which is Christ's and which naturally we do not possess. Herein lies the need of the atonement.<sup>12</sup>

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## God's Names

NAME OF GOD: Elohim

MEANING: The strong, Creator God - Verse: In the beginning God (Elohim) created the heavens and the earth. The earth was formless and void, and darkness was over the surface of the deep, and the Spirit of God (Elohim) was moving over the surface of the waters. Genesis 1:1,2

NAME OF GOD: Jehovah

MEANING: Lord, master and relational God - Verse: This is the account of the heavens and the earth when they were created, in the day that the Lord (Jehovah) God made earth and heaven. Genesis 2:4

NAME OF GOD: Adonai

MEANING: Master Over All - Verse: O Lord God (Adonai) You have begun to show Your servant Your greatness and Your strong hand; for what god is there in heaven or on earth who can do such works and mighty acts as Yours? Deuteronomy 3:24

NAME OF GOD: El Bethel

MEANING: The God of the House of God - Verse: He built an altar there, and called the place El-bethel (El Bethel), because there God had revealed Himself to him when he fled from his brother. Genesis 35:7

NAME OF GOD: Elohim Chaseddi

MEANING: The God of My Mercy - Verse: My God (Elohim) in His lovingkindness (Chaseddi) will meet me; <sup>SEP</sup>God will let me look triumphantly upon my foes. Psalm 59:10

NAME OF GOD: El Elohe Yisrael

MEANING: The mighty God of Israel - Verse: Then he erected there an altar and called it El-Elohe-Israel (El Elohe Yisrael). Genesis 33:20

NAME OF GOD: El Elyon

MEANING: The Most High God - Verse: Nebuchadnezzar then approached the opening of the blazing furnace and shouted, "Shadrach, Meshach and Abednego, servants of the Most High God



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(El Elyon), come out! Come here!” So Shadrach, Meshach and Abednego came out of the fire, Daniel 3:26

NAME OF GOD: El Emunah

MEANING: The Faithful God - Verse: Know therefore that the Lord your God is God; he is the faithful God (El Emunah), keeping his covenant of love to a thousand generations of those who love him and keep his commandments. Deuteronomy 7:9

NAME OF GOD: Elohei Tehillati

MEANING: God of my praise - Verse: My God (Elohei), whom I praise (Tehillati), do not remain silent. Psalm 109:1

NAME OF GOD: El Hakabodh

MEANING: The God of Glory - Verse: The voice of the Lord is over the waters; <sup>[1]</sup>the God of glory (El Hakabodh) thunders; <sup>[2]</sup>the Lord thunders over the mighty waters. Psalm 29:3

NAME OF GOD: Elohim Chayim

MEANING: The Living God - Verse: This is how you will know that the living God (Elohim Chayim) is among you and that he will certainly drive out before you the Canaanites, Hittites, Hivites, Perizzites, Girgashites, Amorites and Jebusites. Joshua 3:10

NAME OF GOD: El Hayyay

MEANING: God of My Life - Verse: By day the Lord directs his love; <sup>[1]</sup>at night his song is with me — <sup>[2]</sup>a prayer to the God (El) of my life (Hayyay). Psalm 42:8

NAME OF GOD: Elohim Kedoshim

MEANING: Holy God - Verse: Joshua said to the people, “You are not able to serve the Lord. He is a holy God (Elohim Kedoshim); he is a jealous God. He will not forgive your rebellion and your sins. Joshua 24:19

NAME OF GOD: El Kanna

MEANING: Jealous God - Verse: You shall not bow down to them or worship them; for I, the Lord your God, am a jealous God (El Kanna), punishing the children for the sin of the parents to the third and fourth generation of those who hate me, Exodus 20:5



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NAME OF GOD: Elohei Ma'uzzi

MEANING: God of My Strength - Verse: God (Elohei) is my strong (Ma'uzzi) fortress; And He sets the blameless in His way. 2 Samuel 22:33

NAME OF GOD: Elohim Machase Lanu

MEANING: God Our Refuge - Verse: Trust in him at all times, you people; <sup>[L]</sup><sub>[SEP]</sub>pour out your hearts to him, <sup>[L]</sup><sub>[SEP]</sub>for God (Elohim) is our refuge (Machase Lanu). Psalm 62:8

NAME OF GOD: Eli Maelekhi

MEANING: God My King - Verse: Your procession, God, has come into view, <sup>[L]</sup><sub>[SEP]</sub>the procession of my God and King (Eli Maelekhi) into the sanctuary. Psalm 68:24

NAME OF GOD: El Nekamoth

MEANING: God that Avengeth - Verse: He is the God (El) who avenges (Nekamoth) me, who subdues nations under me, Psalm 18:47

NAME OF GOD: Elohenu Olam

MEANING: Our Everlasting God - Verse: For this God is our God for ever and ever (Elohenu Olam); <sup>[L]</sup><sub>[SEP]</sub>he will be our guide even to the end. Psalm 48:14

NAME OF GOD: Elohim Ozer Li

MEANING: God My Helper - Verse: Surely God is my help (Elohim Ozer Li); <sup>[L]</sup><sub>[SEP]</sub>the Lord is the one who sustains me. Psalm 54:4

NAME OF GOD: El Rai

MEANING: God Seest Me - Verse: She gave this name to the Lord who spoke to her: "You are the God (El) who sees me (Rai)," for she said, "I have now seen the One who sees me." Genesis 16:13

NAME OF GOD: El Sali

MEANING: God, my Rock - Verse: The Lord lives, and blessed be my rock (El Sali); and exalted be God, the rock of my salvation. 2 Samuel 22:47

NAME OF GOD: El Shaddai



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MEANING: Almighty God - Verse: When Abram was ninety-nine years old, the Lord appeared to him and said, "I am God Almighty (El Shaddai); walk before me faithfully and be blameless. Then I will make my covenant between me and you and will greatly increase your numbers." Genesis 17:1,2

NAME OF GOD: Elohim Shophtim Ba-arets

MEANING: God that Judgeth in the Earth - Verse: Then people will say, "Surely the righteous still are rewarded; surely there is a God who judges the earth (Elohim Shophtim Ba-arets)." Psalm 58:11

NAME OF GOD: El Simchath Gili

MEANING: God My Exceeding Joy - Verse: Then I will go to the altar of God, to God, my joy and my delight (El Simchath Gili). I will praise you with the lyre, O God, my God. Psalm 43:4

NAME OF GOD: Elohim Tsebaoth

MEANING: God of Hosts - Verse: Restore us, God Almighty (Elohim Tsebaoth); make your face shine on us, that we may be saved. Psalm 80:7

NAME OF GOD: Elohe Tishuathi

MEANING: God of My Salvation - Verse: Deliver me from the guilt of bloodshed, O God, you who are God my Savior (Elohe Tishuathi), and my tongue will sing of your righteousness. Psalm 51:14

MEANING: God of My Righteousness Verse: Answer me when I call to you, my righteous God (Elohe Tsadeki). Give me relief from my distress; have mercy on me and hear my prayer. Psalm 4:1

NAME OF GOD: Elohe Yakob

MEANING: God of Jacob - Verse: May the Lord answer you when you are in distress; may the name of the God of Jacob (Elohe Yakob) protect you. Psalm 20:1

NAME OF GOD: Elohei Marom



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MEANING: God of Heights - Verse: With what shall I come to the Lord and bow myself before the God (Elohei) on high (Marom)? Shall I come to Him with burnt offerings, with yearling calves? Micah 6:6

NAME OF GOD: Elohei Haelohim

MEANING: The God of gods - Verse: For the Lord your God is the God of gods (Elohei Haelohim) and the Lord of lords, the great, the mighty, and the awesome God who does not show partiality nor take a bribe. Deuteronomy 10:17

NAME OF GOD: Ehyeh asher Ehyeh

MEANING: The eternal, all-sufficient God - Verse: God said to Moses, "I AM Who I AM"; (Ehyeh asher Ehyeh) and He said, "Thus you shall say to the sons of Israel, 'I AM has sent me to you.'" Exodus 3:14

NAME OF GOD: Jehovah Adon Kol Ha-arets

MEANING: The LORD, the Lord of All the Earth - Verse: See, the ark of the covenant of the Lord of all the earth (Jehovah Adon Kol Ha-arets) will go into the Jordan ahead of you. Joshua 3:11

NAME OF GOD: Jehovah Chereb

MEANING: The LORD... the Sword - Verse: Blessed are you, Israel! Who is like you, <sup>[L]</sup>a people saved by the Lord (Jehovah)? <sup>[L]</sup>He is your shield and helper <sup>[L]</sup>and your glorious sword (Chereb). <sup>[L]</sup>Your enemies will cower before you, and you will tread on their heights. Deuteronomy 33:29

NAME OF GOD: Jehovah Tsaba

MEANING: LORD of Hosts - Verse: Then David said to the Philistine, 'You come to me with a sword, a spear, and a javelin, but I come to you in the name of the Lord of hosts (Jehovah Tsaba), the God of the armies of Israel, whom you have taunted.' 1 Samuel 17:45

NAME OF GOD: Jehovah Gibbor Milchamah

MEANING: The LORD Mighty In Battle - Verse: Who is this King of glory? <sup>[L]</sup>The Lord strong and mighty, <sup>[L]</sup>the Lord mighty in battle (Jehovah Gibbor Milchamah). Psalm 24:8

NAME OF GOD: Jehovah Maginnenu

MEANING: The LORD Our Defense - Verse: Indeed, our shield (Maginnenu) belongs to the Lord (Jehovah), <sup>[L]</sup>our king to the Holy One of Israel. Psalm 89:18





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NAME OF GOD: Jehovah Goelekh

MEANING: The LORD Thy Redeemer - Verse: You will drink the milk of nations<sup>[SEP]</sup> and be nursed at royal breasts. <sup>[SEP]</sup> Then you will know that I, the Lord (Jehovah), am your Savior, <sup>[SEP]</sup> your Redeemer (Goelekh), the Mighty One of Jacob. Isaiah 60:16

NAME OF GOD: Jehovah El Elohim

MEANING: The LORD God of gods, the LORD, mighty, powerful, strong One over all - Verse: The Mighty One, God, the Lord (Jehovah), the Mighty One (El), God (Elohim), the Lord! He knows, and may Israel itself know. If it was in rebellion, or if in an unfaithful act against the Lord do not save us this day! Joshua 22:22

NAME OF GOD: Jehovah Elohim

MEANING: The LORD God - Verse: This is the account of the heavens and the earth when they were created, in the day that the Lord (Jehovah) God (Elohim) made earth and heaven. Genesis 2:4

NAME OF GOD: Jehovah El Emeth

MEANING: LORD God of Truth - Verse: Into Your hand I commit my spirit; <sup>[SEP]</sup> You have ransomed me, O Lord (Jehovah), God (El) of truth (Emeth). Psalm 31:5

NAME OF GOD: Jehovah El Gemuwal

MEANING: The LORD God of recompense - Verse: For the destroyer is coming against her, against Babylon, <sup>[SEP]</sup> And her mighty men will be captured, <sup>[SEP]</sup> Their bows are shattered; <sup>[SEP]</sup> For the Lord (Jehovah) is a God (El) of recompense (Gemuwal), <sup>[SEP]</sup> He will fully repay. Jeremiah 51:56

NAME OF GOD: Jehovah Elohim Tsaba



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MEANING: LORD God of Hosts - Verse: You, O Lord (Jehovah) God (Elohim) of hosts (Tsaba), the God of Israel, <sup>[[[SEP]]]</sup>Awake to punish all the nations; <sup>[[[SEP]]]</sup>Do not be gracious to any who are treacherous in iniquity. Psalm 59:5

NAME OF GOD: Jehovah Elohim Yeshua

MEANING: The Son of God - Verse: Simon Peter answered, 'You are the Christ the Son (Ben) of the living God (Elohim).' Matthew 16:16

NAME OF GOD: Elohei Mikkarov

MEANING: God who is near - Verse: Am I a God (Elohei) who is near (Mikkarov), declares the Lord, and not a God far off? Jeremiah 23:23

NAME OF GOD: Elohei Chasdi

MEANING: God of my kindness, goodness and faithfulness - Verse: O my strength, I will sing praises to You, <sup>[[[SEP]]]</sup>For God is my stronghold, the God (Elohim) who shows me lovingkindness (Chasdi). Psalm 59:17

NAME OF GOD: Elohim Bashamayim

MEANING: God in Heaven - Verse: When we heard it, our hearts melted and no courage remained in any man any longer because of you; for the Lord your God, He is God (Elohim) in heaven (Bashamayim) above and on earth beneath. Joshua 2:11

NAME OF GOD: Jehovah Hashopet

MEANING: The LORD the Judge - Verse: I have not wronged you, but you are doing me wrong by waging war against me. Let the Lord (Jehovah), the Judge (Hashopet), decide the dispute this day between the Israelites and the Ammonites. Judges 11:27

NAME OF GOD: Jehovah Hoshiah

MEANING: O LORD Save - Verse: Lord (Jehovah), give victory (Hoshiah) to the king! <sup>[[[SEP]]]</sup>Answer us when we call! Psalm 20:9

NAME OF GOD: Jehovah Immeka

MEANING: The LORD Is with You - Verse: When the angel of the Lord appeared to Gideon, he said, "The Lord (Jehovah) is with you (Immeka), mighty warrior." Judges 6:12



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NAME OF GOD: Sar Shalom

MEANING: Prince of Peace - Verse: For a child will be born to us, a son will be given to us; and the government will rest on His shoulders; and His name will be called Wonderful Counselor, Mighty God, Eternal Father, Prince of Peace (Sar Shalom). Isaiah 9:6

NAME OF GOD: Jehovah Jireh

MEANING: The LORD Will Provide - Verse: So Abraham called that place The Lord Will Provide (Jehovah Jireh). And to this day it is said, "On the mountain of the Lord it will be provided." Genesis 22:14

NAME OF GOD: Jehovah Kanna Shemo

MEANING: The LORD Whose Name Is Jealous - Verse: Do not worship any other god, for the Lord (Jehovah), whose name (Kanna) is Jealous (Shemo), is a jealous God. Exodus 34:14

NAME OF GOD: Jehovah Mochsi

MEANING: The LORD my Refuge - Verse: If you say, "The Lord (Jehovah) is my refuge (Mochsi)," and you make the Most High your dwelling, Psalm 91:9

NAME OF GOD: Jehovah Magen

MEANING: The LORD my Shield - Verse: Blessed are you, Israel! Who is like you, a people saved by the Lord (Jehovah)? He is your shield (Magen) and helper and your glorious sword. Your enemies will cower before you, and you will tread on their heights." Deuteronomy 33:29

NAME OF GOD: Jehovah Mauzzi

MEANING: The LORD my Fortress - Verse: Lord (Jehovah), my strength and my fortress (Mauzzi), my refuge in time of distress, to you the nations will come from the ends of the earth and say, "Our ancestors possessed nothing but false gods, worthless idols that did them no good. Jeremiah 16:19

NAME OF GOD: Jehovah Ha-Melech

MEANING: The LORD the King - Verse: With trumpets and the blast of the ram's horn—shout for joy before the Lord (Jehovah) the King (Ha-Melech). Psalm 98:6

NAME OF GOD: Peleh Yo'etz



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MEANING: Wonderful Counselor - Verse: For unto us a Child is born, Unto us a Son is given; and the government will be upon His shoulder. And His name will be called Wonderful (Peleh), Counselor (Yo'etz), Mighty God, Everlasting Father, Prince of Peace. Isaiah 9:6

NAME OF GOD: Jehovah Mephalti

MEANING: The LORD my Deliverer - Verse: The Lord (Jehovah) is my rock, my fortress and my deliverer (Mephalti); <sup>[SEP]</sup>my God is my rock, in whom I take refuge, <sup>[SEP]</sup>my shield and the horn of my salvation, my stronghold. Psalm 18:2

NAME OF GOD: Jehovah Mekaddishkem

MEANING: The LORD that Sanctifies You - Verse: Say to the Israelites, 'You must observe my Sabbaths. This will be a sign between me and you for the generations to come, so you may know that I am the Lord (Jehovah), who makes you holy (Mekaddishkem). Exodus 31:13

NAME OF GOD: Jehovah Metsudhathi

MEANING: The LORD My High Tower - Verse: The Lord (Jehovah) is my rock, my fortress (Metsudhathi) and my deliverer; my God is my rock, in whom I take refuge, my shield and the horn of my salvation, my stronghold. Psalm 18:2

NAME OF GOD: Jehovah Moshiekh

MEANING: The LORD Your Savior - Verse: I will make your oppressors eat their own flesh; <sup>[SEP]</sup>they will be drunk on their own blood, as with wine. NAME OF GOD: Jehovah Nissi

MEANING: The LORD My Banner - Verse: Moses built an altar and called it The Lord (Jehovah) is my Banner (Nissi). Exodus 17:15

NAME OF GOD: Jehovah Ori

MEANING: The LORD My Light - Verse: The Lord (Jehovah) is my light (Ori) and my salvation—whom shall I fear? <sup>[SEP]</sup>The Lord is the stronghold of my life—of whom shall I be afraid? Psalm 27:1

NAME OF GOD: Jehovah Rophe

MEANING: The LORD (our) Healer - Verse: He said, "If you listen carefully to the Lord your God and do what is right in his eyes, if you pay attention to his commands and keep all his decrees, I



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will not bring on you any of the diseases I brought on the Egyptians, for I am the Lord (Jehovah), who heals (Rophe) you.” Exodus 15:26

NAME OF GOD: Jehovah Roi

MEANING: The LORD My Shepherd - Verse: The Lord (Jehovah) is my shepherd (Roi), I lack nothing. Psalm 23:1

NAME OF GOD: Ruach Hakkodesh

MEANING: Holy Spirit - Verse: Do not cast me away from Your presence<sup>[SEP]</sup> And do not take Your Holy Spirit (Ruach Hakkodesh) from me. Psalm 51:11

NAME OF GOD: Jehovah Sal'I

MEANING: The LORD My Rock - Verse: The Lord (Jehovah) is my rock (Sal'I), my fortress and my deliverer<sup>[SEP]</sup>; my God is my rock, in whom I take refuge, <sup>[SEP]</sup>my shield and the horn of my salvation, my stronghold. Psalm 18:2

NAME OF GOD: Jehovah Shalom

MEANING: The LORD (our) Peace - Verse: So Gideon built an altar to the Lord there and called it The Lord Is Peace (Jehovah Shalom). To this day it stands in Ophrah of the Abiezrites. Judges 6:24

NAME OF GOD: Jehovah Shammah

MEANING: The LORD Is There - Verse: The distance all around will be 18,000 cubits. And the name of the city from that time on will be: the Lord is there (Jehovah Shammah). Ezekiel 48:35

NAME OF GOD: Jehovah Tsidkenu

MEANING: The LORD Our Righteousness - Verse: In his days Judah will be saved<sup>[SEP]</sup> and Israel will live in safety. This is the name by which he will be called: <sup>[SEP]</sup>The Lord (Jehovah) Our Righteous (Tsidkenu) Savior. Jeremiah 23:6

NAME OF GOD: Immanuel

MEANING: God with us - Verse: Therefore the Lord Himself will give you a sign: Behold, a virgin will be with child and bear a son, and she will call His name Immanuel (Immanuel). Isaiah 7:14

NAME OF GOD: Go'el





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MEANING: Kinsman Redeemer - Verse: In Your lovingkindness You have led the people whom You have redeemed (Go'el); <sup>[SEP]</sup>In Your strength You have guided them to Your holy habitation. Exodus 15:13

NAME OF GOD: Kadosh

MEANING: The Holy One - Verse: To whom then will you liken Me<sup>[SEP]</sup> that I would be his equal? says the Holy One (Kadosh). Isaiah 40:25

NAME OF GOD: Ruach Elohim

MEANING: The Spirit of God -Verse: When they came to the hill there, behold, a group of prophets met him; and the Spirit of God (Ruach Elohim) came upon him mightily, so that he prophesied among them. 1 Samuel 10:10

NAME OF GOD: Jehovah Malakh

MEANING: The Angel of the Lord - Verse: Now the angel of the Lord (Jehovah Malakh) found her by a spring of water in the wilderness, by the spring on the way to Shur. Genesis 16:7

NAME OF GOD: Jehovah Tsemach

MEANING: The Branch of the Lord - Verse: In that day the Branch of the Lord (Jehovah Tsemach) will be beautiful and glorious, and the fruit of the earth will be the pride and the adornment of the survivors of Israel. Isaiah 4:2

NAME OF GOD: Esh Oklah

MEANING: A Consuming Fire - Verse: For the Lord your God is a consuming fire (Esh Oklah), a jealous God. Deuteronomy 4:24

NAME OF GOD: 'Ab

MEANING: Father - Verse: A father ('Ab) of the fatherless and a judge for the widows,<sup>[SEP]</sup> Is God in His holy habitation. Psalm 68:5

NAME OF GOD: 'Or Goyim

MEANING: Light of the Nations - Verse: I am the Lord, I have called You in righteousness, I will also hold You by the hand and watch over You,<sup>[SEP]</sup> And I will appoint You as a covenant to the people,<sup>[SEP]</sup> As a light to the nations ('Or Goyim). Isaiah 42:6
