Jesus' Kindness is throughout the Bible in many stories, miracles, and events. But one event was concerning Mary Magdalene. Her story is recorded in all four books of the gospels of Matthew, Mark, Luke and John.

Luke 8:1-2 (KJV) 1) And it came to pass afterward, that he went throughout every city and village, preaching and shewing the glad tidings of the kingdom of God: and the twelve were with him, 2) And certain women, which had been healed of evil spirits and infirmities, Mary called Magdalene, out of whom went seven devils". It was here we learn that she was healed of evil spirits.

- Luke 1:26-38

3. Jesus' Birth

- Matthew 2:1-7

4. Jesus' lifestyle is the same as his Father's.

- God's Holiness - Isaiah 57:16, Psalm 99:9, 1 Peter 1:15-16, Ephesians 4:30, Proverbs 15:9, 26
- God's Righteousness - Psalm 116:5, Ezra 9:15, Psalm 145:17, Jeremiah 12:1
- God' Mercy & Loving-kindness - Eph. 2:4; Rom. 5:8, Romans 8:32, Psa. 103:8, Psa. 33:10
- God's Love - 1 John 4:8-16, 1 John 3:16; John 3:16, Matt 3:17, Matt 17:5, Luke 20:13

5. Whatever the Father tells him do he did it.

- John 5:19 - Then answered Jesus and said unto them, Verily, verily, I say unto you, The Son can do nothing of himself, but what he seeth the Father do: for what things so ever he doeth, these also doeth the Son likewise

13. Jesus is the word of God and His Attributes is like his Father in his present place

- Ephesians 2:6-9 (KJV) ⁶ And hath raised us up together and made us sit together in heavenly places in Christ Jesus: ⁷ That in the ages to come he might shew the exceeding riches of his grace in his kindness toward us through Christ Jesus. ⁸ For by grace are ye saved through faith; and that not of yourselves: it is the gift of God: ⁹ Not of works, lest any man should boast.
- John 1:1-14 - Jesus is the word of God and therefore He is like the attributes of His Father

The word "Omni" means "all"

- God is Omniscience - because He is the word of God Jesus has knowledge, wisdom, understanding, is touched by feels of your infinities.
- God's Omnipotence - Because the Holy Spirit who is the present of God and has authority, power like His Father.
- God's Omnipresence - because He is the word of God is at the same place at the same time
- God's Eternity - Because He is presently in Heaven on the right hand of His Father Jesus exist in eternity and is affected due to time. He does not know the time that we will be returning for His bride the church and therefore he is affected by time. This knowledge is only known by the Father.

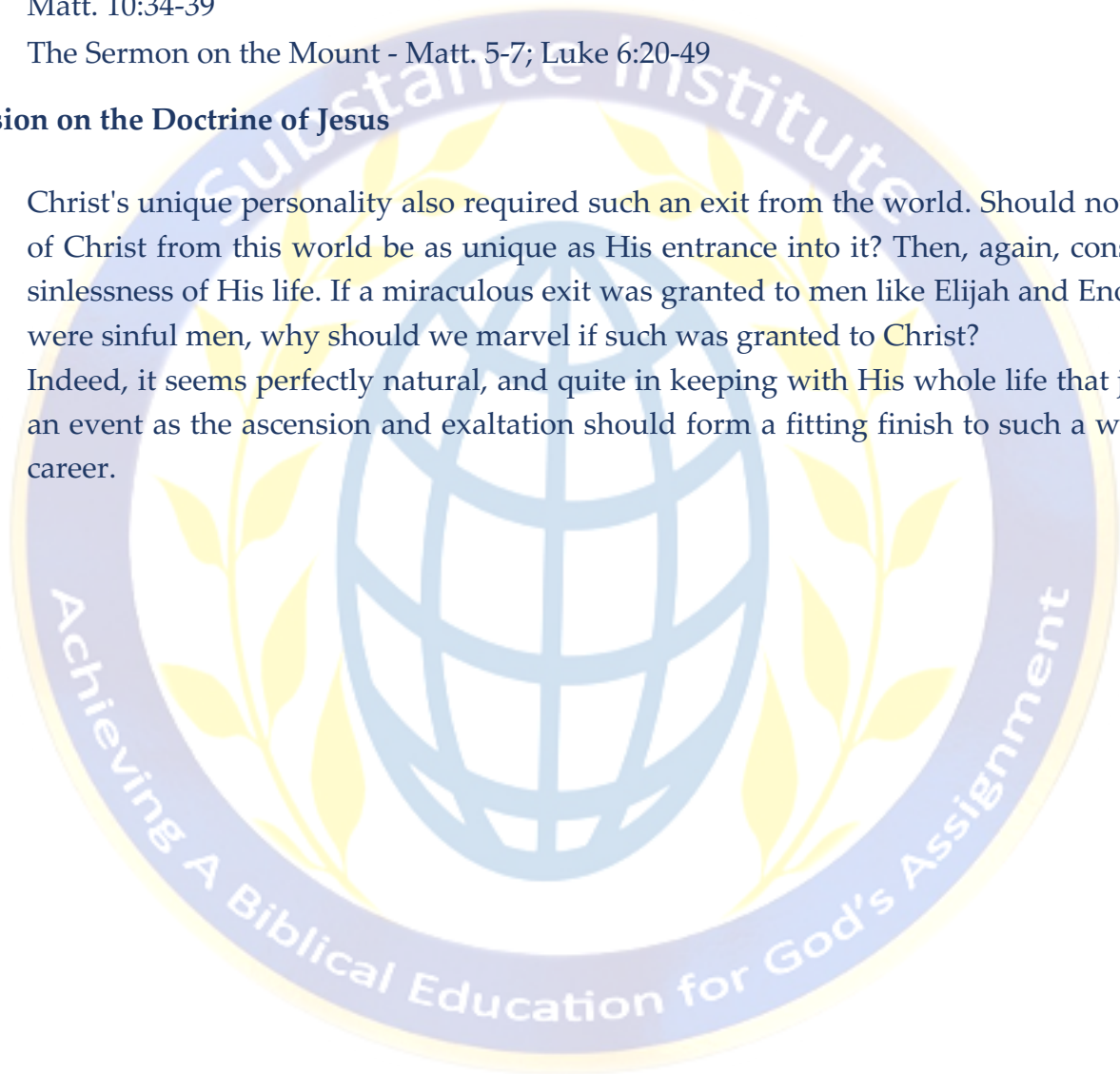

Conclusion on the Doctrine of Jesus
