

Genesis 20:17

So Abraham **prayed** unto God: and God healed Abimelech, and his wife, and his maidservants; and they bare children.

Numbers 11:2

And the people cried unto Moses; and when Moses **prayed** unto the LORD, the fire was quenched.

Numbers 21:7

Therefore the people came to Moses, and said, We have sinned, for we have spoken against the LORD, and against thee; pray unto the LORD, that he take away the serpents from us. And Moses **prayed** for the people.

Deuteronomy 9:20

And the LORD was very angry with Aaron to have destroyed him: and I **prayed** for Aaron also the same time.

Deuteronomy 9:26

I **prayed** therefore unto the LORD, and said, O Lord GOD, destroy not thy people and thine inheritance, which thou hast redeemed through thy greatness, which thou hast brought forth out of Egypt with a mighty hand.

1 Samuel 1:10

And she was in bitterness of soul, and **prayed** unto the LORD, and wept sore.

1 Samuel 1:27



For this child I **prayed**; and the LORD hath given me my petition which I asked of him:

1 Samuel 2:1

And Hannah **prayed**, and said, My heart rejoiceth in the LORD, mine horn is exalted in the LORD: my mouth is enlarged over mine enemies; because I rejoice in thy salvation.

1 Samuel 8:6

But the thing displeased Samuel, when they said, Give us a king to judge us. And Samuel **prayed** unto the LORD.

2 Kings 4:33

He went in therefore, and shut the door upon them twain, and **prayed** unto the LORD.

2 Kings 6:17

And Elisha **prayed**, and said, LORD, I pray thee, open his eyes, that he may see. And the LORD opened the eyes of the young man; and he saw: and, behold, the mountain was full of horses and chariots of fire round about Elisha.

2 Kings 6:18

And when they came down to him, Elisha **prayed** unto the LORD, and said, Smite this people, I pray thee, with blindness. And he smote them with blindness according to the word of Elisha.

2 Kings 19:15

And Hezekiah **prayed** before the LORD, and said, O LORD God of Israel, which dwellest between the cherubims, thou art the God, even thou



alone, of all the kingdoms of the earth; thou hast made heaven and earth.

2 Kings 19:20

Then Isaiah the son of Amoz sent to Hezekiah, saying, Thus saith the LORD God of Israel, That which thou hast **prayed** to me against Sennacherib king of Assyria I have heard.

2 Kings 20:2

Then he turned his face to the wall, and **prayed** unto the LORD, saying,

2 Chronicles 30:18

For a multitude of the people, even many of Ephraim, and Manasseh, Issachar, and Zebulun, had not cleansed themselves, yet did they eat the passover otherwise than it was written. But Hezekiah **prayed** for them, saying, The good LORD pardon every one

2 Chronicles 32:20

And for this cause Hezekiah the king, and the prophet Isaiah the son of Amoz, **prayed** and cried to heaven.

2 Chronicles 32:24

In those days Hezekiah was sick to the death, and **prayed** unto the LORD: and he spake unto him, and he gave him a sign.

2 Chronicles 33:13

And **prayed** unto him: and he was intreated of him, and heard his supplication, and brought him again to Jerusalem into his kingdom. Then Manasseh knew that the LORD he was God.



Ezra 10:1

Now when Ezra had **prayed**, and when he had confessed, weeping and casting himself down before the house of God, there assembled unto him out of Israel a very great congregation of men and women and children: for the people wept very sore.

Nehemiah 1:4

And it came to pass, when I heard these words, that I sat down and wept, and mourned certain days, and fasted, and **prayed** before the God of heaven,

Nehemiah 2:4

Then the king said unto me, For what dost thou make request? So I **prayed** to the God of heaven.

Job 42:10

And the LORD turned the captivity of Job, when he **prayed** for his friends: also the LORD gave Job twice as much as he had before.

Isaiah 37:15

And Hezekiah prayed unto the LORD, saying,

Isaiah 37:21

Then Isaiah the son of Amoz sent unto Hezekiah, saying, Thus saith the LORD God of Israel, Whereas thou hast **prayed** to me against Sennacherib king of Assyria:

Isaiah 38:2

Then Hezekiah turned his face toward the wall, and **prayed** unto the LORD,



Jeremiah 32:16

Now when I had delivered the evidence of the purchase unto Baruch the son of Neriah, I **prayed** unto the LORD, saying,

Daniel 6:10

Now when Daniel knew that the writing was signed, he went into his house; and his windows being open in his chamber toward Jerusalem, he kneeled upon his knees three times a day, and **prayed**, and gave thanks before his God, as he did aforetime.

Daniel 9:4

And I **prayed** unto the LORD my God, and made my confession, and said, O Lord, the great and dreadful God, keeping the covenant and mercy to them that love him, and to them that keep his commandments;

Jonah 2:1

Then Jonah prayed unto the LORD his God out of the fish's belly,

Jonah 4:2

And he **prayed** unto the LORD, and said, I pray thee, O LORD, was not this my saying, when I was yet in my country? Therefore I fled before unto Tarshish: for I knew that thou art a gracious God, and merciful, slow to anger, and of great kindness, and repentest thee of the evil.

Matthew 26:39

And he went a little farther, and fell on his face, and **prayed**, saying, O my Father, if it be possible, let this cup pass from me: nevertheless not as I will, but as thou wilt.



Matthew 26:42

He went away again the second time, and **prayed**, saying, O my Father, if this cup may not pass away from me, except I drink it, thy will be done.

Matthew 26:44

And he left them, and went away again, and **prayed** the third time, saying the same words.

Mark 1:35

And in the morning, rising up a great while before day, he went out, and departed into a solitary place, and there **prayed**.

Mark 5:18

And when he was come into the ship, he that had been possessed with the devil **prayed** him that he might be with him.

Mark 14:35

And he went forward a little, and fell on the ground, and **prayed** that, if it were possible, the hour might pass from him.

Mark 14:39

And again he went away, and **prayed**, and spake the same words.

Luke 5:3

And he entered into one of the ships, which was Simon's, and **prayed** him that he would thrust out a little from the land. And he sat down, and taught the people out of the ship.

Luke 5:16

And he withdrew himself into the wilderness, and prayed.



Luke 9:29

And as he **prayed**, the fashion of his countenance was altered, and his raiment was white and glistering.

Luke 18:11

The Pharisee stood and **prayed** thus with himself, God, I thank thee, that I am not as other men are, extortioners, unjust, adulterers, or even as this publican.

Luke 22:32

But I have **prayed** for thee, that thy faith fail not: and when thou art converted, strengthen thy brethren.

Luke 22:41

And he was withdrawn from them about a stone's cast, and kneeled down, and **prayed**,

Luke 22:44

And being in an agony he **prayed** more earnestly: and his sweat was as it were great drops of blood falling down to the ground.

John 4:31

In the mean while his disciples **prayed** him, saying, Master, eat.

Acts 1:24

And they **prayed**, and said, Thou, Lord, which knowest the hearts of all men, shew whether of these two thou hast chosen,

Acts 4:31



And when they had **prayed**, the place was shaken where they were assembled together; and they were all filled with the Holy Ghost, and they spake the word of God with boldness.

Acts 6:6

Whom they set before the apostles: and when they had **prayed**, they laid their hands on them.

Acts 8:15

Acts 9:40

Acts 10:2

And Cornelius said, Four days ago I was fasting until this hour; and at the ninth hour I **prayed** in my house, and, behold, a man stood before me in bright clothing,

Acts 10:48

And he commanded them to be baptized in the name of the Lord. Then **prayed** they him to tarry certain days.



Acts 13:3

And when they had fasted and **prayed**, and laid their hands on them, they sent them away.

Acts 14:23

And when they had ordained them elders in every church, and had **prayed** with fasting, they commended them to the Lord, on whom they believed.

Acts 16:9

And a vision appeared to Paul in the night; There stood a man of Macedonia, and **prayed** him, saying, Come over into Macedonia, and help us.

Acts 16:25

And at midnight Paul and Silas **prayed**, and sang praises unto God: and the prisoners heard them.

Acts 20:36

And when he had thus spoken, he kneeled down, and **prayed** with them all.

Acts 21:5

And when we had accomplished those days, we departed and went our way; and they all brought us on our way, with wives and children, till we were out of the city: and we kneeled down on the shore, and **prayed**.

Acts 22:17

And it came to pass, that, when I was come again to Jerusalem, even while I **prayed** in the temple, I was in a trance;



Acts 23:18

So he took him, and brought him to the chief captain, and said, Paul the prisoner called me unto him, and **prayed** me to bring this young man unto thee, who hath something to say unto thee.

Acts 28:8

And it came to pass, that the father of Publius lay sick of a fever and of a bloody flux: to whom Paul entered in, and **prayed**, and laid his hands on him, and healed him.

James 5:17

Elias was a man subject to like passions as we are, and he **prayed** earnestly that it might not rain: and it rained not on the earth by the space of three years and six months.

And he **prayed** again, and the heaven gave rain, and the earth brought forth her fruit.
