Your role as intercessors is essential part, the key, the primary, bottom-line, significant, necessary for your church and ministry. Prayer guarantee which are God's promises to you.

God's guarantee is the foundation of your prayers being answered for your church and all that concerns you and people you are assigned to pay for which are as follows:

- 1 John 5:14-15 ...according to His will
- John 14:14 ...in my name I will do it
- Mark 11:23 ...shall say and shall not doubt in His heart ... shall have whatsoever ever he says

Summary of your Fundamental Life of the Church is this “if you ask anything in my will, in my name, and do not doubt, but believe what you say, you will receive”.

Understanding C.O.M.A of Intercession

Natural COMA means is not a state of prolonged unconsciousness, including a lack of response to stimuli from which it is impossible to rouse a person.

Spiritual COMA means is a lack of response to stimuli one's relationship with the Father.

As intercessors you are used to stimulate (excite, inspire, motivate, encourage, quicken, increase and promote) a person who is hurting / in a crisis through prayer.

Birthing through Prayer Spiritually

1 Kings 18:41-45 KJV ⁴¹ And Elijah said unto Ahab, Get thee up, eat and drink; for there is a sound of abundance of rain.

⁴² So Ahab went up to eat and to drink. And Elijah went up to the top of Carmel; and he cast himself down upon the earth, and put his face between his knees,

⁴³ And said to his servant, Go up now, look toward the sea. And he went up, and looked, and said, There is nothing. And he said, Go again seven times.

⁴⁴ And it came to pass at the seventh time, that he said, Behold, there ariseth a little cloud out of the sea, like a man's hand. And he said, Go up, say unto Ahab, Prepare thy chariot, and get thee down that the rain stop thee not.

⁴⁵ And it came to pass in the mean while, that the heaven was black with clouds and wind, and there was a great rain. And Ahab rode, and went to Jezreel.

1. **Travail Pray** – Birthing through Prayer

2. **First Pray** then Expect, not expect then Pray

3. **Pray with Determination** - to Prayer for the Results

4. **No matter What Pray** – Don't be alert by what you see or feel or hear, because of the opposition the answer is coming.

5. **Pray with Boldness** - Bold Faith

6. **Praying God's Will to be done** - Answered Prayer

7 Characteristics of an Intercessor

Intercessors Insight and understand things through God's eyes.

- Having the insight through God's eyes is different than understanding the word with your eyes.
- Only when we are able have the insight of the world and its situations with God's insight, you will do what Nehemiah 1:1-5 did. (sat down, wept, mourned, fasted and prayer before the God of Heaven)

Intercessors are broken (cracked, smashed, damaged, ruined, and destroyed people) of God.

- The things that we have insight through God's eyes may shattered our hearts.
- What shattered God's heart must shattered ours.
- Only then can true intercession begin. (Jeremiah 8:21)

Intercessors when you pray DO NOT use God for their own benefit.

- They allow God to use them.
- They are God's conduits to pray and bless people.
- Abraham was used to be blessed.

A Spiritual Characteristics about Intercession

7 Characteristics of an Intercessor

Intercessors are marking devices of God – Spiritual Prayer Flag (Ezekiel 9:1-11)

- Intercessors has God's attention
- Daniel was called 'greatly beloved' by God, after he began interceding for his people. (Daniel 9:23; 10:11,19)
- The Angel put a mark on the foreheads of those who mourn for the land. (Ezekiel 9:4)

Intercessors are not assigned to pray but are called to pray.

- Their lives are an example of having effective and efficient prayer lives
- Their lives are wanting to do to what Jesus is doing.
- Their lives are always repenting for their sins and for others.

Intercessors are givers of their time, tips and gifts (money).

- Their time to pray and their good works go together

Intercessors prayers can change the mind of God

- Moses changed God's mind. (Exodus 32:32, Psalms 106:23)
- Hezekiah prayed and God changed his mind (2 Kings 20:1-6)
- If the nation intercedes with repentance, God will forgive the nation and heal the land. (2 Chronicles 7:14)
