The Functions of An Intercessor Who Risk & Sacrifice

- There is a difference between a person who is called an intercessor and a person who prays.
- Any person can pray, but not all praying people are intercessors.
- The opposite is true also - an intercessor may live his entire life and live to make only one great act of intercession.
- The differences of an intercessor are subtle - hidden in the life and heart behind the prayer.
- There are many examples of intercessors in the Bible, and they walked with the favor to impact and change God's heart.



TO BOLDLY DEFEND (Heb 4:16)

- Defended with boldness.
- This does not necessarily mean they had naturally bold personalities.
- Watch a mother or father bird when a threat comes too close to their nest!
- God has placed within His creation an instinct to defend the young.
- An intercessor's heart comes to the surface when they perceive a threat.
- Suddenly the heart of a pussy cat turns into the roar of a lion.





TO VOLUNTEER (John 15:13)

- One of the marks of an intercessor is a willingness to do something.
- A volunteer is someone who is not necessarily asked, rather he/she steps forward in order to accomplish something.
- Jesus said there is no greater love than to lay down one's life for his friends.

- **HINGE INTERCESSORS** - Es 5:7; 1 Sam 25:33; Gen 41:46
- **FORERUNNER INTERCESSORS** - 2 Sam 24:17; 1 Sam 30:8
- **LIVING SIGNS INTERCESSORS** - Hosea marrying the harlot and Isaiah walking around naked and barefoot - through submission / obedience in areas that goes against the religious status quo
- **SPIRIT OF ELIJAH INTERCESSORS** - Malachi 4:6 & James 5:16-18
- **PRIEST INTERCESSORS** - Gen 14:18; Ps 110:4; Heb 5:6,10; Heb 6:20; Heb 7:1,10-11,15,17,21; 1 Peter 2:5
- **DELIVERER INTERCESSORS** - Ex 7:12, 8:18; 1Kings 18:36-39; Obadiah 1:21
- **DOOR KEEPER INTERCESSORS** - Isa 22:22-23, Rev 3:7-10, Matthew 16:19



8 PILLARS OF A LIVING INTERCESSOR

- 1. Intercessors are Volunteers - *Isa 6:8-11*
- 2. Intercessors have the Gift of Giving and receive pleasure in sacrifice, even if bittersweet. *Ps 50:5* and *Isa 53:10-11*
- 3. Intercessors have great Faith for breakthrough when in the midst of the sufferings of many loved ones. *1 Sam 30:6-8*
- 4. Intercessors have Hope enough to visualize the victory, the point of breakthrough. *Rom 5:3-5*
- 5. Intercessors have stubborn love. *1 Cor 13:7, 1 Peter 4:7-8 & 1 Cor 13:1-13*
- 6. An Intercessor is marked with great Favor of being daily loaded with benefits. *Ezra 7:19-20*
- 7. An Intercessor knows the power of walking in Peace. *Rom 16:19-20*
- 8. An Intercessor becomes God's Partner and is willing to express His heart in whatever way He sees fit to express it. *Ex 33:12-17*

What is Intercession and Intercessory Prayer?

- Intercession causes us to internalize God's Word and changes us.
- Intercession unites our heart to people and places we pray for.
- Intercession renews our hope and faith.
- Intercession imparts life (John 6:63).
- Intercession makes a long-term impact beyond this age (Rev. 5:8, 8:1-6).
- Intercession humbles us.
- Intercession changes the spiritual atmosphere of cities and nations.
- Intercession causes multiple blessings to return to the intercessor (Luke 6:38).
